

Short biography, Angélique Flöter Rådestad, MD, PhD, Associate Professor

Angélique Flöter Rådestad, born in 1964, is a specialist in obstetrics/gynecology with subspecialization in gynecological tumour surgery and gynecology. She is an associate Professor and her research is mainly clinical within the field of quality of life after cancer. She also has several translational projects in ovarian cancer and BRCA-mutation. Her thesis in 2004 was about testosterone treatment in oophorectomized women and effects on sexuality, well-being and metabolism.

Currently she is holding a position as senior consultant at the department for gynecology at Karolinska University Hospital in Stockholm. She is associated to several research groups at Karolinska Institutet and Karolinska University Hospital. She is former chairwoman of the Swedish expert working group for gynecological cancer and has actively been involved in the authorship and implementation of national guidelines for gynaecological cancer.
