The position of Deputy Medical Director of CTU has been opened by the Foundation Board of NSGO Clinical Trial Unit, for applications by NSGO members for the period 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2021.

The tasks of the Deputy Medical Director, which will be agreed with Medical Director, include but are not necessarily limited to:

- To work together with Medical Director and the Strategic Working Group of the CTU Scientific Committee with new and planned trials as well as trial proposals (assisting in preparation of protocols and clinical trial agreements, designing trial budgets etc.)
- To assist Medical Director in interaction with the sites
- To assist Medical Director in collaboration with co-operative groups (ENGOT, GCIG, AGO, GINECO etc.)
- To familiarize her/himself with the work of the GCIG Harmonization Group

We are looking for a person, who:

- is a member of NSGO,
- is a gynecologic oncologist, a medical oncologist, a radiation oncologist or a general gynecologist with special interest in gynecologic oncology,
- has immense experience with clinical trials
- has experience in the treatment of gynecologic cancer patients,
- has authored and co-authored original publications in peer-reviewed scientific journals,
- is fluent in English
- is willing and able to travel to intergroup and other scientific meetings.

No other financial compensation than reimbursement of travel costs related to activities as Deputy Medical Director is provided. However, Deputy Medical Director will have an excellent chance to networking in the gynecologic-oncological community and to training for the design and conduct of clinical trials as well as to co-authorships of scientific articles in accordance with ENGOT rules.
